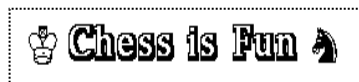


THE BATH 2015 JUNIOR CHESS TOURNAMENT

Limited parking at school (during event only), free parking on surrounding streets

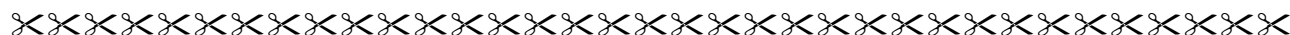
This will be a “Swiss Tournament” of 6 rounds. All players play in all rounds: no one gets knocked out. All abilities are welcome, but children should be capable of playing a full day’s chess. Prizes will be awarded for different age groups and/or at the controller’s discretion, depending on participating numbers. Clocks will be used on all boards. All moves to be played in 25 minutes for each player.

This event is organised by Somerset Primary Schools Chess Association and it is open to any player under 12 on (and all ages are ‘as at’) 31st August 2014. Places are limited and, if oversubscribed, places will be allocated in order of receipt. Early entry is therefore recommended to avoid disappointment. Closing date for receipt of entries: Monday 13 April 2015.

Information supplied on the entry form may be held on a computer for the purpose of grading, plus selected photographs games & prize giving may be used to publicise this/future events. It is a condition of entry that players agree to photographs and grading information being published.
